Family Discussion Guide 1 Corinthians 15 April 19, 2020

Summary:

If Jesus were not raised from the dead, then He was not who He claimed to be. Sin was not paid for, trust in Jesus does no good. People would have no hope and will die in their sins separated from God. But we already know Jesus did rise from the dead. His resurrection is proof that all who trust in Jesus will rise also. The believers alive when Jesus returns and those who have did will all be changed. Resurrected bodies will be like Jesus' resurrected body. Death will be destroyed. Believers can be sure that they will rise from the dead.
