Why do you think Nicodemus came to Jesus at night (3:1-2)?

What did Nicodemus believe about Jesus (3:2)? Why?

Jesus told Nicodemus "unless a person is born (anōthen), he cannot see the kingdom of God" (3:3). The Greek adverb (anōthen) commonly meant "from above" or sometimes "again" referring to a repeated event. Which way did Nicodemus understand Jesus' statement (3:4)? What do you think Jesus intended?

What is the difference between being born of the flesh and born of the Spirit (3:6)?

How are the workings of the Holy Spirit similar to the workings of the wind (3:8)?

How would you describe what it means to be born from above (3:7) or, born of the Spirit (3:8) to someone?

What are the absolute truth statements that Jesus makes in this passage?

The expressions "verily, verily" (KJV) "very truly" (NIV) "solemn truth" (NET) in these verses indicate strong declarations of truth, Jesus intends that we understand these statements as absolutes.

Why are spiritual absolutes hard to understand?

What is the outcome of faith in Jesus, the Son of Man (3:15-16)?

Why did God send His Son into the world (3:17)?

How did the Holy Spirit use other people, events and God's word to bring you to faith in Jesus?
