The Spirit Helps Us in Our Weakness

In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for...

Romans 8:26a (NIV)

by Interceding for Us

...but the Spirit himself intercedes for us through wordless groans. And he who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit... Romans 8:26b–27a (NIV)

according to the Will of God.

...because the Spirit intercedes for God's people in accordance with the will of God.

Read It!

In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us through wordless groans. ²⁷ And he who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for God's people in accordance with the will of God.

Open It!

Who has helped you learn to pray? What did their help look like?

Consider It!

Paul uses a word for help that only appears four times in the Bible. Help means to take up with, lend a hand together with, or share in carrying a load. Look at these four passages to identify who, what and how someone needs help.

- Exodus 18:13-22 (v. 22)
- Numbers 11:16-17 (v. 17)
- Luke 10:38-40 (v. 40)

Our weakness in prayer is defined by Paul as not knowing what to pray or to ask regarding a particular need (8:26). For what kinds of needs do you find it challenging to pray?

Who is the one that knows our hearts and the mind of the Spirit (8:27; 2 Chronicles 16:9; Psalm 139:1, 23; Proverbs 17:3; Acts 1:24)?

What help does the Holy Spirit give us in our praying (8:26-27)?

What do you find encouraging in this passage?

How might your prayer life change because of these promises?

Live It!

Make a prayer list of difficult things, the things for which you don't know how you ought to pray.

Take these difficult things to the Lord in prayer.

Heavenly Father, I need your help. Sometimes I don't know how to pray. I thank you for the gift of your Holy Spirit who lives in me. I am grateful that He helps carry my unexpressed burden to you in prayer. Today I bring (name the difficulty) to You knowing that Your Spirit will intercede on my behalf according to your perfect will. Thank you, in the name of Jesus, Amen.
