Who are 21st Century enemies of the cross within the church? What messages do they proclaim that diminish the message of the cross?

Where is your citizenship (3:20)?

Who is speaking into your life? Whose message is influencing your thoughts and actions?

How can you ensure that Christ is Lord of your thoughts and actions (3:21; Romans 12:1-2)?
