How We Forgive One Another

"Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you." Ephesians 4:32

THE POINT: Forgiven people are to be forgiving people. 7 characteristics mark how you are to forgive:	
1. We are to forgive F	_ – Matthew 10:8
2. We are to forgive O	_ – Luke 23:34
3. We are to forgive R	_ – Matthew 18:22
4. We are to forgive G	_ – Ephesians 1:7-8
5. We are to forgive <u>I</u>	_ – Luke 17:3-5
6. We are to forgive V	_ – Matthew 18:35
7. We are to forgive E	_ – Psalm 103:12
Response – being 'doers' of the Word (James 1:22):	

"Then the Lord said, 'Look, I am setting a plumb line among my people...." Amos 7:8b – Adjusting our lives to be aligned with God's Word-THE plumb line Scripture text: Ephesians 4:25-32 [NIV]
